

[KYLIN-4241]:Dynamically reload user's security configuration with properties or yaml config

Instructions

1) replace related spring config in `kylinSecurity.xml` with `customUserDetailsService`

```
<property name="userDetailsService">
    <bean class="org.apache.kylin.rest.service.KylinUserService">
        <constructor-arg>
            <util:list value-
type="org.springframework.security.core.userdetails.User">
                <ref bean="adminUser"></ref>
                <ref bean="modelerUser"></ref>
                <ref bean="analystUser"></ref>
            </util:list>
        </constructor-arg>
    </bean>
</property>
```

like this

```
<property name="userDetailsService" ref="customUserDetailsService"></property>
```

2) add related config parameters in `kylin.properties`

```
# Turn on dynamic loading
kylin.security.auth.config.dynamic.load.enabled=true
# config file relative path in classpath or Absolute path
# config file format: properties or yaml, exmaple: test_meta/kylin-user.yaml
kylin.security.auth.config.filename=kylin-user.yaml
# reload config interval
kylin.security.auth.config.dynamic.load.interval-in-minute=5
```

3) restart your kylin process
